


Leading Flourishing Schools High Performance Leadership Teams Development Program

1. Why High Performance School Leadership Teams?

The High Performance School Leadership Teams Program (HPT) is the No.1 School Leadership Team Development Program in Australia.

To fast-track the transformation of your school, your Leadership Team is the 'No. 1 Team' needing to be optimised to the highest possible performance. Yet many school leadership teams are not optimised for high performance per se with gaps and overlaps in reporting processes, competing agendas, differing personalities and inadequate team time.



On top of this, many schools are embracing new ways of working at a time where the fundamentals of clear reporting lines and effective teamwork have slipped and change fatigue is increasing. By building a High Performance School Leadership Team, the foundations are laid for the success of new ways of working such as Instructional Leadership, Cycles of Inquiry and the use of the School Improvement Hierarchy.



2. <u>How</u> Does The High Performance Leadership Teams Program Work?

The High Performance School Leadership Teams Program is a 3 stage School Leadership Team development program. The program typically consists of 4 x 1 day team workshops spread across three stages with Team Pulse, executive coaching and 360 feedback support. We also encourage a strong action research focus on key school improvement goals during the program.



3. Who Should Attend - Cluster & Site Specific Programs

We recommend all members of the School Leadership Team (i.e., Principals, DPs, APs, HoSES, HoCs, HoDs, BMs etc.) complete each stage of the program together. The program can be run as a 'site specific' strategy within a single school and is also ideally suited to a 'cluster' or network approach where multiple school leadership teams can meet together and collaborate through each stage of the program.
